

### DIGITAL WAYFINDING WEBAPP

LizFinder is the solution to navigating the complexities within a healthcare facility compound (Outdoor + Indoor navigation). By providing an interactive map and directory,

- Users simply scan the Wayfinding webApp QR codes using their smartphones for instant access to detailed maps and navigation tools, directory information on key services and available amenities.
- The mobile interface is user-friendly, guarantees a smooth experience navigating Mount Elizabeth Hospital.
- Coverage extends to Mount Elizabeth Orchard Campus, including our Heeren, Paragon, and Lucky Plaza Units.

The Campus directory, include operating hours, & precise location. Some listings may include a website link for more information.

- Patients / Visitors can scan the QR code to access from any point
- QR codes are placed strategically throughout the Mount Elizabeth Orchard Campus.

Waypoint pictures offer visual reference to aid in location identification.

- **Tap and Go**: Select your destination directly on the map for instant directions.

### **NEW ENDOSCOPY CENTRE**

On 31 July 2024, we officially opened our Endoscopy Centre.

With the seven endoscopy procedure rooms launched in December 2023, the Centre is now a full-fledged facility, complete with 38 recovery beds (up from 23) and an Admissions Office.

Our new centre is 123% larger and will serve the increasing endoscopic demands. It boasts robotic automation, including clean and dirty scope deliveries by robots and a StamiLift for easier bed transfers. The centre is equipped with modern patient monitoring systems and pendants to enhance patient care.

We thank our past and present Endoscopy Committee Chairpersons Dr Kieron Lim and Dr Ling Khoon Lin for their guidance to achieve these two milestones.

## VEHICULAR CIRCULATION

As we commence renovations to upgrade the **Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre (MEMC) Drop-Off** Point / Taxi Stand, we would like to inform you of the following changes to vehicular access, with effect from **1 September 2024 (Till March 2025):** 

### From Sep 2024:

Preparation work in Carpark – Removal, Remarking & Painting for traffic diversion.

### From Oct 2024:

Hoarding works begin. One driveway lane designated for drop-offs. Please use other available drop-off points.


### From Nov 2024 – Dec 2024:

No Entry The drop-off point closed. Please use other available drop-off points.

### From Jan 2025 onwards:

One driveway lane will be open from 7:00am to 3:00pm. Outside of these hours, please use other available drop-off points.

### **ALTERNATIVE** DROP-OFF & PICK UP AREA

1. Drop-Off between MEMC Block and Hospital Block B (after the Gantry)





2. Drop-Off at Hospital Lobby A, near the Urgent Care Centre



3. Drop-Off at Paragon Medical Centre and Lucky Plaza Apartment Block.





### **BUS SERVICE**



New Location of Shuttle Bus Pickup at Jalan Elok

### FREE SHUTTLE SERVICES

Our shuttle bus services which will temporarily relocate to Jalan Elok area, near Radiation Oncology from 1 October 2024.

To reach this location, proceed from Hospital Drop Off B (near CT Centre), head towards the Urgent Care Centre (UCC), and continue straight past the UCC. This change applies to both shuttle bus services plying the routes of Mount Elizabeth Novena Hospital and Gleneagles Hospital. Shuttle Bus Schedule will be shared.

### **ADDITIONAL** DROP-OFF & PICK UP AREA

### Drop-Off Locations between MEMC and Hospital Block B

A new drop-off location will be created between the two green plant pillars, replacing the current six parking lots next to the handicapped lots. There are two available dropoff points (as depicted in the images) after the gantry, to help alleviate traffic congestion

Please note that waiting and parking will NOT be allowed at the drop-off areas to ensure smooth traffic flow. The carpark entrance to the hospital will remain, and additional traffic marshals will be deployed to guide drivers.

Lane Allocations for Medical Centre Drop-Off

### Linkway to MEMC

Construction will commence from end Aug 2024 and expected to complete by 2nd Quarter of 2025. Time: 8am to 6pm (excluding Sunday and Public Holidays)

From August 2024, the contractors appointed by Land Transport Authority (LTA) will commence the construction of the sheltered linkway to connect MEMC to Lucky Plaza.



On 20 August 2024, as a part of this project, a tree [A] [refer below] at the intersection of Orchard Road & Mount Elizabeth Road (next to Lucky Plaza) was removed to accommodate the construction of new linkway.
